 - Article V, Governing Board Section 4. Term and Term Limits. [New added language]: To protect the legacy and continuity of the OPNC Board, fifty percent (50%) of the total eighteen (18) At-Large Board Seats will be up for election after 12 months, commencing in year 2018; the remaining fifty percent (50%) At-Large Board Seats will be up for election the following consecutive year. Four At-Large Board Seats "East" of Crenshaw Blvd and Four At-Large Board Seats "West" of Crenshaw Blvd will be select by the current Board Members. The Youth At-Large Board Seat will remain for a full two-year seating.
