Public comment is limited to 2 minutes per speaker, unless adjusted by the presiding officer of the Board.

Proposal to locate such "slow streets" on:
    - i. 12th Street between La Brea and Queen Anne Place
    - ii. Country Club Drive between Bronson Avenue and Western Avenue
    - iii. 12th Street between Western Avenue and Normandie Avenue
  - j. Discussion and possible motion to send letter to Mayor's office, LADOT, Streets LA and CD10 requesting that as the city expedites street repaving during the COVID-19 pandemic, that it implement the already-approved Mobility Plan 2035 (including any bus or bike lanes specified in that plan) when repaving streets, or delay such repaving until such a time as Mobility Plan 2035 can be implemented.
