Therefore, by providing funding for this NPG request you will assist us in breaking the cycle of poverty, homelessness and criminal behavior. PESA's methodology: insert aid into every area that is a consequence or determinant of homelessness, poverty or criminal justice involvement. This serves a valuable public purpose and benefits the public at large by addressing the pipeline that leads to poverty, homelessness and criminal behavior.


Purpose of Form


